

City of Nacogdoches and Nacogdoches Aeromodelors Club
A.L. Mangham Jr. Regional Airport
Site Use Agreement

This document creates an agreement between the Nacogdoches Aeromodelors Club (NAC) and the City of Nacogdoches' A.L. Mangham Jr. Regional Airport (OCH) regarding the use of a portion of the OCH by the NAC as the designated and official NAC club field. The NAC may utilize a portion of the site as designated by the Airport Manager and NAC understands that all activities may continue at the discretion of the Airport Manager.

The OCH Airport Manager agrees to:

1. Allow access of NAC members to the designated site.
2. Allow NAC members to erect a shade cover at an approved site near the NAC flight area.
3. Notify NAC members when the OCH site will be closed to NAC activities.
4. Allow NAC members to operate radio controlled model aircraft in accordance with this agreement.

The NAC officers and members agree to:

1. Occupy and use the OCH airport site in accordance with this agreement.
2. Supply the Airport Manager with current copies of AMA insurance coverage, FAA Circular #91-57 regarding Model Aircraft Operating Standards, current copies of safety rules, a roster of club members, and emergency contact numbers for NAC officers (copies attached).
3. All members using the OCH site must be active members of the Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA).
4. All members using the OCH site must be members of the NAC or a guest of the NAC member as AMA rules allow.
5. All NAC members agree to conform to all AMA safety rules (attached).
6. The NAC site at OCH will have a spectator area, pit area, pilot line, taxi area, safety line and runway laid out as closely as possible to AMA Recommended RC Flying Site Specifications guideline.
7. NAC will post a copy of AMA rules and NAC rules the rules at the OCH site.
8. In addition to AMA safety rules, NAC members additionally agree to:
 - a. Enter and exit the OCH site in accordance with the Airport Manager's instructions (map attached).
 - b. Clean up any and all trash and/or debris from the NAC site prior to leaving the OCH site at the end of a flying session.
 - c. Agree that all full-scale aircraft have right of way at all times at the OCH site.
 - d. Will not overfly any roadway, taxiway, operational runway, building or aircraft (map of allowed overfly area attached).
 - e. Will contact Airport Manager or the Nacogdoches Police Department if a modeling accident results in property damage or injury to non-NAC club member property or individual.

- f. NAC will be responsible for maintaining all NAC owned property to include shade cover, signage, aircraft starting stands, or any other NAC property.
 - g. No items are to be left at the NAC/OCH site in an unsecured manner so that wind will not blow any items off the NAC flying site.
9. Any movable structures or other property developed by NAC for use by NAC members will remain the property of NAC and will be removed in the event that this agreement is terminated.

This agreement will remain in effect until terminated by either OCH or NAC. OCH agrees to give NAC ninety (90) days notice of agreement termination unless the Airport Manager deems this agreement detrimental to OCH property, tenants or the flying public. In such a case, this agreement will be terminated upon demand.

The City of Nacogdoches' A.L. Mangham Jr. Regional Airport and the Nacogdoches Aeromodelors Club agree to the terms stated above.
